## Why is there a blue dot on my tree?

Your tree was inspected by the Royal Oak  
Sustainability and Arboriculture Department to  
determine if your tree is healthy or if it is in need of  
removal. The following reasons:

- Storm damage/structural issues
- Disease/fungus
- Root rot
- Construction damage

The "blue dot" indicates removal at a future date  
— typically within six months.

The good news is trees removed by the city  
— typically for a large replacement tree.
